新高中「其他學習經歷」

在新學制的改革之下,各學習範疇均有所重整。除語文及選修科外,亦特別重視個人、社會及人文教育,讓學生認識自我,認識社會,及至國家的歷史文化。

除了課堂所學,本校亦積極提供不同的活動及學習經歷,加強課堂學習與社會 的聯繫,讓學生觀察和體驗種種社會實況。

辯論隊透過參加不同形式的辯論比賽,加強學生的思辯能力及演説技巧。透過探討不同的政治、經濟、民生以及道德議題,當中涉及通識教育、中國歷史、經濟、宗教及倫理科等的學習內容。學生在探討辯題背景、搜集資料的過程中,能調動所學之餘,也增加探討社會議題的興趣。在討論策略時,透過隊員之間的意見交流,以及跟其他與賽隊伍的理性討論,能提升思考力及組織能力。隨著科技進步,學界辯賽的規模不斷拓展,本校同學於本年度與多間本港國際學校,以及來自廣東省、上海、北京、新加坡等地的學生,透過視像以粵語或英文辯論,與不同文化背景的學生進行思想交流。

去年,辯論隊以及其他高中同學參加由香港電台舉辦的錄影節目《窮富翁再戰 江湖》論壇,透過與對賽學校的辯論,探討香港貧富懸殊問題以及社會仇富、仇商 情緒的關係。同學更有機會和學者、商界代表交流。在活動中學生透過親身體驗貧 窮,真正走出校園,認識社會。

此外,亦有《模擬法庭、公義教育計劃》,透過參與模擬法庭審訊的過程,在庭內扮演不同角色,包括控辯雙方律師、被告、證人等,使學生親身了解及反省法律與公義等概念之餘,也能了解本港的法治制度及精神,讓學生將來更加積極關注社會。同學處理的模擬案件涉及範疇甚廣,如人際衝突、販毒及藏毒、三合會及網絡罪行等,以不同角度探討犯罪行為的後果和影響,全面提升同學對社會議題的分析及批判能力。

健康校園計畫

為響應政府在全港學校推行健康校園政策,本校於去年成立健康校園政策專責小組,並舉辦一連串的多元化活動,幫助學生培養健康的生活習慣、建立正面的人生觀,及抗拒誘惑的技巧。去年,除於九月二十四日舉行了以「抗拒誘惑,積極思想,關懷分享」的話劇晚會外,亦邀請了路德會青怡中心和警民關係主任到校作活動分享,讓同學認識毒品的禍害及掌握抗拒誘惑的技巧。此外,本校亦參與由香港天主教教區學校聯會與香港警務處毒品調查科合辦的「網上禁毒通通識,攜手創造健康校園」活動,以加強同學健康生活的意識。

今年,本校以「勇於嘗試,敢於承擔」(Take on, Push on, Lead on)作為「健康校園」的主題。開學日早上,一群德育及公民教育大使於校門以歡欣的心情迎接同學回校,並向同學派發印有「勇於嘗試,敢於承担」的原子筆,校園上下充滿著積極、歡樂的氣氛。而在開學禮上剛畢業的校友,以其面對挑戰的經歷鼓勵同學敢於嘗試,校長亦勉勵同學以突破自我及敢於承擔的精神,迎向挑戰。

本校今年亦繼續參與「網上禁毒通通識,攜手創造健康校園」計劃,並將有關課程融入學校的校本課程及活動,讓同學實踐健康生活。此外,本校同學亦參與一個名為「心連心,夢飛翔」的心卡設計比賽,將積極、鼓勵的精神與國內同學分享。

The New Senior Secondary Curriculum has brought numerous challenges to our school. At the same time, it also brings ample opportunities for students to learn and prepare themselves for their future.

One of those precious learning opportunities is preparing students for job interview. Students take an active role in preparing themselves inside out, from getting their attire ready to practicing possible interview questions. Students step up to challenges by facing their weaknesses and fear. One of the most valuable lessons is preparation is always the key to success.

Preparation for job interview is one of the key modules in English Language curriculum. It is also a significant process in everyone's life. There are so many books and online materials telling young people how they should prepare a job interview. However, Shun Lee teachers believe nothing is better than walking students through an authentic process of a job interview.

In collaboration with the Department of English, Careers Team organized a Mock Job Interview Day for both Secondary 6 and 7 students in October. Before their big day, students attended a series of workshops related to job interview ranging from writing resume and cover letter, presenting themselves effectively, doing company research, anticipating interview questions to learning business

etiquette and attire. To make the job interview experience more authentic, students were assigned a real job opening; based on which students wrote their resume and cover letter as well as did necessary preparation for the job interview.

This year both Secondary 6 and 7 students strived for a post, Charity Officer, offered by Hong Kong Jockey Club. In their business formal, 240 candidates from Secondary 6 and 7 involved in both interviews and presentations. The highlight of the Mock Job Interview was the individual interview of the finalists. Walking with confidence into the school hall, the finalists were interviewed by a panel of four teachers. In front of their peers and interviewers, they exhibited their knowledge of the company and enthusiasm for the job. They strived to stay calm, to appear confident and professional and at the same time, to produce the best answers to impress the panelists. It is never an easy task for a young person who has no job experience, yet the five-minute individual interview has made a profound impact on the young candidates' lives.

The business formal our students put on has raised the curtain on their adulthood. In face of challenges ahead, our dear students would say proudly "Yes, I am ready!"









There has been a multitude of comparisons between Hong Kong and Singapore in our society. The best way for the young generation to understand the two world-class cities is, of course, to see them in person.

40 of our Secondary Four students participated in a study tour to Singapore in April. They studied four major areas, namely environmental protection, housing policies, study life and cultures in Singapore. The delegates went to the Housing and Development Board to learn more about government policies on housing in Singapore. They also visited NEWater, Marina Barrage and Land Transport Gallery to see how the Singaporean government carries out different measures to reuse and recycle resources as well as reduce the negative impact of the transport system on environment.

Students also visited Underwater World in Sentosa and Night Safari for a close and exciting encounter with marine life and other animals. They also experienced the multi-cultural facets of Singapore through a city walk in Little India and China Town.

The highlight of the study tour was the visit to our partner school, St. Joseph's Convent. Our students introduced Hong Kong to their newly-met friends. They also had a taste of what studying in Singapore is like by attending lessons in St. Joseph's Convent. Young people from both cities exchanged their ideas in classrooms and broadened their cultural perspectives through a learning journey on Preservation and Revitalization. The delegates had a wonderful stay in St. Joseph's Convent and were impressed by the positive learning attitude of their Singaporean counterparts.

Our students brought home more than souvenirs from Singapore, but living values for their personal growth and a wide range of knowledge and issues that have an impact on their daily lives, their community and even the wider world. The five-day journey has made a huge difference in our students' personal growth and intellectual development.

Pass it on...

The friendship between Shun Lee and St. Joseph's Convent has budded since the study tour in 2010. Like last year, our dear Singaporean friends paid a visit to Shun Lee in May, following our stay in St. Joseph's Convent. The presence of SJC students filled our campus with joy and laughter.

Sharing the same religious belief, the two schools decided to make the study tour 2011 more meaningful and educational. Young people from both schools paid a visit to the elderly living in Shun Lee Estate.

Bringing along with their souvenirs, students from both schools warmed the hearts of the elderly with love and respect. During the visit, our students explained to their friends from Singapore about the life of senior citizens in Hong Kong. They also exchanged ideas of government policies on elderly welfare in both cities. The visit was a unique experience for students from both schools to learn and work together for a good cause.

The Shun Lee – St. Joseph's Convent Study Tour 2011 came to a perfect end but the Tales of the Two Cities does not. The friendship between the two schools is continuously blooming and students from both cities will set to learn from each other and pass their Christian values on through the study tour in 2012.





其實午膳時間是學生寶貴的學習時機,就是訓練獨立、管理、與人溝通、保護 自己的好機會,這是人生道上必須要學會的基本技能,而且越早學會就越好,做家 長的應鼓勵孩子走出去。

資訊科技的發展

本校早於一九九八年獲選為二十所資訊科技先導學校之一,推行資訊科技教學。自此,學校設立了內聯網系統,促進資訊傳送及教材分享,加強學生與教師的溝通,提升學與教的質素。學校近年已多次更換電腦及引入精簡型電腦 (Thin client) 等設備,又參加優質教育基金撥款之『運用新科技處理學校行政工作』計劃,使用智能卡系統提升行政工作的效能,改善行政效率,減輕教師在行政方面的負擔。

隨著應用的層面愈廣,電腦網絡也成為學校不可或缺的部份。去年,學校更換了網絡交換器及更換光纖主幹等網絡設備,提升了伺服器及客戶端的傳輸率,提升網絡管理效能以應付未來學與教的需要。剛過去的暑假,學校又新增了一些最新無線網路標準(即802.11n) 的無線網路基地台(AP)及更換了「閘道器」(Gateway) 等網絡設備。新型號的無線網路基地台不單提供更高的傳輸速率,通過專屬控制器(AC)管理基地台,能夠提供更高質素的網絡連線。「閘道器」的主要作用是連接網外網絡,尤指互聯網。學校選用了國內學界廣為使用的《易閘道》EASYGATE,該產品能同時提供抵禦網外的惡意攻擊和管理網內瀏覽活動的功能,提供一個安全的環境給同學上網學習。



語文教育支援計畫的推廣

去年本校中文科参加了教育局的語文教育支援計畫,成效理想,不論是學生的寫作意識,又或是老師的評改尺度都見明顯的改善。今年中文科繼續參與有關的計畫,焦點之一在完成對首屆新高中學生三年的寫作表現追踪;焦點之二則在優化選修單元的設計。透過科組同事與支援人員的集體備課、共同觀課及教學交流,進一步提升學與教的效能,並把經驗推廣至各級,以優化成果。
