

Summary Report of the use of Diversity Learning Grant (DLG) 2024-25

Objective of DLG:

- To subsidize gifted senior secondary students (i.e. S4-6 students) to take more structured learning opportunities of Gifted Education through school-based pull-out programmes and/or off-school support programmes (e.g. credit-bearing courses offered by tertiary education institutions, enhancement programmes offered by academic associations or professional bodies)

Total Amount of DLG: \$84000 (\$7000 per senior secondary class per year, a total of 12 S4-6 classes)

- **Stable Subsidy Allocation:** Continued support for exchange programmes across various regions

Suggestion for 2025–26

- **Personalized Support:** Provide subsidies for Gifted & Talented students based on **individual consultation and specific needs.**
- **Flexible Programme Selection:** Encourage participation in diverse enrichment opportunities tailored to students' strengths and aspirations.

Subsidy Rules for Gifted Education Programmes

Gifted programmes typically cost **\$1,000–\$5,000**, which can be a burden for grassroots families. Subsidy breakdown:
